This volume has been produced to celebrate the eightieth birthday in June 1999 of Professor John Macquarrie. A selection of lectures marking important milestones in his life has also been included, among them his inaugural lectures at Union Theological Seminary, New York and Christ Church, Oxford, and lectures given before the Russian Academy of Sciences in Moscow and the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences in Beijing.
