Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Nuclear energy policy issues facing Congress include the implementation of federal incentives for new commercial reactors, radioactive waste management policy, research and development priorities, power plant safety and regulation, terrorism, and the Price-Anderson Act nuclear liability system. The Bush Administration has called for an expansion of nuclear power. For Department of Energy (DOE) nuclear energy research and development, the Administration requested \$389.9 million for FY2006. The FY2006 Energy and Water Development appropriations bill signed by the President on November 19, 2005, provides \$420.2 million (P.L. 109-103, H.Rept. 109-275). The bill provides an additional \$157.4 million to DOE's Office of Nuclear Energy, Science, and Technology from other appropriations accounts, for a total of \$557.6 million -- about \$44 million more than the Administration's total request. Significant incentives for new commercial reactors are included in the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (P.L. 109-58), signed by the President August 8, 2005. These include production tax credits, loan guarantees, insurance against regulatory delays, and extension of Price-Anderson. The act also authorizes \$1.25 billion for the design and construction of a...
